
On Watego's.

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Virgin billionaire Sir Richard Branson recently rated Rae's On Watego's as the best place he's ever stayed. "It's only got about seven bedrooms and I highly recommend it," says the well-traveled Branson.

For those seeking extensive cosseting, the spa is an unsurpassed experience where celebrities such as Elle Macpherson flock for spa guru Marionne de Candia's fabulous anti-ageing facials. "On my last day [on holiday] there I had an amazing facial - my skin looked so fresh," says Macpherson.
